### Happy Canada Day

#### 4:30 pm All Aboard

The gangway is raised and we're off to our first port-of-call, Key West, Florida (170.1 nautical miles). The ms Westerdam sails at 5:00 pm.

#### From the Navigator

Upon clearing the harbor of Port Everglades and disembarking the pilot we will set a southerly course into the Straits of Florida, passing Miami around 7:00 pm. To avoid the Gulf Stream, a strong northerly current which averages 2.5 knots (1 knot = 1 nautical mile per hour = 1.15 statute miles), we will sail along the coast of Florida as close as safely possible. During the night we will slowly change course to a south westerly direction keeping the Florida Keys on our starboard or right hand side. We expect to approach the Key West Pilot Staion at around 6:00 am.

Use the staircases and not the elevators unless you are physically challenged, because in the event of a real emergency the elevators may be inoperable. Please wear your lifejacket, which you will find in your cabin, and dress warmly.

All ship's services will be suspended during this exercise.
