Hotel Manager Willem Cruijsberg

Willem Cruijsberg was born and raised in Tegelen, in the province of Limburg close to the German border. The town of 25,000 is known for its Passion Play performed every five years. No wonder Cruijsberg's favorite comment is: "Everything is possible; miracles take a little longer."

Decipher the Stripes

The who's who of chiphord personnel can be a confusing to

The who's who of shipboard personnel can be a confusing task. Are you still trying to decipher the stripes from one officer's uniform to the next? Who belongs to which department?

Basically, each department ship is distinguished by its own stripe pattern. The deck department, including the captain, has gold bars, one of which is looped. (The deck department is also called the navigation department, and a deck officer is called a navigator.) A sub-department within the navigation department is the radio department, whose gold stripes are lined with green.

The engineering department is distinguished by all straight gold bars. The chief engineer has four gold bars, second engineers have three, third engineers have two, and fourth have one gold stripe.

The hotel department is recognizable by their straight gold stripes with white sandwiched between. Although a part of the hotel department, the medical team also has straight gold, bars with red filling.

When in doubt, you can always ask. But following these simple guidelines, you should be able to figure out who's who of shipboard personnel.

Notice

While coming in and out of ports, you may notice a slight vibration. This is due to the bow and stern thrusters being used to maneuver the ship.
