# Cruise Director - Susan Wood

One of Susan Wood's ancestral grandfathers was a captain who was lost at sea in 1621. She's the second member of her family to work aboard ships and has been much more fortunate to keep her head above water. Educated to become a pharmacist, Wood's love of dancing overtook her ambitions. A student of dance since the age of five, she eventually earned a spot on the British Dance Team representing her country worldwide. Spotted by a cruise ship director, she was swept off the dance floor and onto the seas as a dance instructor. After being seasick for two weeks, she vowed never to board a ship again. However, a short while later, she gained her sea legs and was hooked. Selling her dance studio in England, she spent the next four years teaching dance on ships before being tapped to become an assistant cruise director.

Working for Holland America Line for the past six years, Wood was quickly promoted to cruise director and was the first woman ever to hold such a position within the fleet. Although she dispensed with her dancing shoes to enter the world of management, she never lost her zest for entertainment and is highly visible to guests both on- and off- stage.

She enjoys "the challenge of being able to satisfy the needs of guests on board and meeting so many new people."

Wood was raised in Newcastle-upon-Tyne, 60 miles from the Scottish border. Her accent is a delightful blend of English, Scottish with a pinch of Norwegian, the remnants of a much earlier Viking time in northeast England. When not at sea, she spends time renovating her haunted castle located amidst the rolling hills of England.

# From the Navigator

This morning, sailing on a course of 306 degrees we will approach the most westerly point of Cuba, Cabo San Antonio, around 6:30 am. Here we will alter course to north, 360 degrees into the Yucatan Channel. Approximately one hour later we will alter course to a north easterly direction sailing in the Gulf of Mexico, along the coast of Cuba at a distance of about 8 miles. Around noon we will enter the Straights of Florida and slowly approach the Florida Keys. To take advantage of the strong Gulf Stream averaging 2.5 knots, we will stay at a distance of at least 15 miles from the coast.
