CRUISE DIRECTOR CHRIS JURASAS

Cruise Director Chris Jurasas is often asked jokingly, "What do you do for a living?" Although Chris frequently appears to be having fun chatting with guests or organizing an activity to make the cruise more enjoyable, behind the scenes is another story. There is real work in planning each cruise with enough activities and entertainment to appeal to over 1,200 guests, but Chris wouldn't have it any other way. His job, as he puts it, is "like nothing else in the world." The world was a major consideration when Chris joined Holland America Line at the age of 21. Intrigued by both travel and entertainment, Chris saw that ships were the way to fulfill both dreams. He chose to start with the top cruise company and since his first cruise on the ms Noordam, Chris worked hard to become Holland America Line's youngest-ever Cruise Director. Travel is a big part of Chris's history. Born in Vilnius, Lithuania, he and his parents were expelled from the former Soviet Union when Chris was 6 years old. Over the next year, the family lived in Vienna and Munich before settling in New York City for nine years. Chris went back to Munich to attend high school and to receive an International Baccalaureate degree before returning to New York to complete a college degree in theater. While not at sea, Chris resides in Seattle, Washington, where he enjoys skiing, driving, exploring remote forests of the Cascade Mountains on his off-road motorcycle and, believe it or not, travelling to exotic locations. Far from being a landlubber, Chris said, "Once the salt is in your veins, the call of the sea cannot be ignored."

SEA SWELLS

A swell is the motion caused by a meteorological disturbance, which persists after the disturbance has died down or moved away. Swells often travel for considerable distances out of their generating area, maintaining a constant direction as long as it stays in deep water. As the swell travels away from its generating area, its height decreases, though its length and speed remains constant, giving rise to the long, low regular undulations so characteristic of swell. Two or three swells from different generating areas are often present, and these may be partially obscured by the waves also present. In the North Pacific Ocean, swells are normally average in length. In the South Pacific, most swells are short or average in length, but waves of more than 984 ft (300 meters) in length occur quite often and it is in this ocean that the longest swells occur.

DUTY FREE: THE REAL MEANING

For hundreds of years, a major source of income for many countries has been import duty. The taxes levied on items brought in on ships, camels, horseback, cars, buses, trucks, and planes by importers, returning vacationers, and business people have helped to swell the coffers of all governments through the ages. "Duty Free" is a term which applies to an item which is sold without any additional taxes being applied at the time of purchase. When the purchaser returns to his or her homeland, there is another set of rules to be considered. These are the Customs laws. Every country has them and they vary from country to country. They dictate the value or quantity of goods that an individual may bring into the country "free of import duty," and anything brought in to the country over and above that defined amount is liable to "import duty."
