Captain Hans van Biljouw received his captain's appointment in January 1990. He joined Holland America in 1962 upon graduation from the nautical academy Kweekschool voor de Zeevaart in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. His first assignment was as an apprentice deck officer on board the ss Andijk, a freighter with accommodations for 12 passengers. Born on June 28, 1942, in Zwollerkerspel, the Netherlands, Captain van Biljouw currently lives in Vorden, the Netherlands - a picturesque village surrounded by eight castles dating to the Middle Ages.

He is married and has three daughters. He is an avid tennis player, but above all his interests is horseback riding. He has his own 17-hand black gelding hunter, and the highlight of the year comes in November when he pretends to hunt the fox. "Sailing for Holland America is a privilege and a pleasure. We have beautiful ships, an excellent crew and an enormous variety of itineraries," says Captain van Biljouw. "The job of captain is divine; it is a world without boundaries, a world of power, challenge, romance and elegance. It is a personal adventure and a way of life."
