This morning we continued sailing along the coast of Cat Island, heading for Half Moon Cay. Upon arrival, the bow of the ms Zuiderdam will be brought over waters of a depth of approximately 15 meters or 45 feet and once in position the anchor will be set.

As soon as the Local Authorities have cleared the ship, tender operations will commence. After weighing anchor this afternoon, the ms Zuiderdam will set sail for Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
